





PROMESH316® security screens are constructed using our unique Retaining Hook System.


Manufacture involves a 60 tonne hydraulic press forming a foldback portion along all sides of the mesh. The mesh grips within the recess of the frame, locked under tension and cannot be removed. To complete the process, a corrosion insulator and finishing wedge is applied.



Why choose SecureVision®? SecureVision® uses an extra heavy duty aluminium frame with contoured face for improved strength and added style. The receiving channel is extra deep for additional security. Restricted vision security mesh (3mm thick) is secured within the door framing creating a privacy barrier from people outside your home. The SecureVision® design works best when there is lighting outside (day light or night light) and very little lighting inside. SecureVision® security doors are harder to cut or penetrate. Designed to not only keep the flies or mosquitoes out but the burglars as well. All SecureVision® security doors are custom built to suit your exact requirements.




